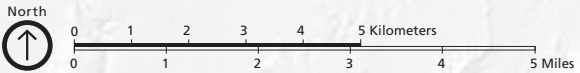

Wilderness
In 2009, Congress protected nearly 84
percent of the park as wilderness under
the 1964 Wilderness Act. Wilderness
designation protects forever the land's
wilderness character, natural conditions,
opportunities for solitude, and scientific,
educational, and historical values.
